

Terms of Use and Medical Disclaimer

Emergency warning

1. Acceptance and scope

These Terms govern access to and use of the public website operated for Radiant Minds Psychiatry, LLC. By using the website, you agree to these Terms. If you do not agree, do not use the website. These Terms do not replace any patient agreement, informed consent, financial policy, telehealth consent, privacy notice, or other document signed in connection with care.

2. Educational information only

Website content is general educational information. It is not medical, psychiatric, psychological, nursing, legal, or other professional advice; it is not a diagnosis or treatment plan; and it should not be used to start, stop, or change medication or care. Health information changes, and content may not reflect your circumstances. Seek advice from a qualified professional who can evaluate you.

3. No provider-patient relationship through website use

Browsing the website, sending a message, submitting an appointment request, joining a mailing list, or completing a complimentary 15-minute fit consultation does not create a provider-patient relationship and does not obligate the Practice to accept you for care. A treatment relationship begins only after the Practice confirms acceptance, completes required intake steps, and provides clinical services under applicable agreements. A fit consultation is not an evaluation, diagnosis, prescription visit, psychotherapy session, crisis service, or source of individualized medical advice.

4. Practice scope and access limits

The Practice offers outpatient psychiatric services to adults age 18 and older. It is not an emergency department, hospital, inpatient unit, detoxification program, partial-hospitalization program, intensive outpatient program, walk-in clinic, or crisis-response service. The Practice does not hold itself out on this website as providing treatment for schizophrenia or a primary substance use disorder. Clinical appropriateness is determined case by case.

5. Telehealth

Telehealth is generally available only when the patient is physically located in Nevada at the time of service and when the clinician determines telehealth is clinically appropriate and legally permitted. Identity and location may be verified at each visit. Technology failure, privacy limitations, clinical risk, licensure rules, payer rules, or emergency needs may require rescheduling or in-person care.

6. Medications, controlled substances, testing, and documentation

No website statement guarantees a diagnosis, prescription, medication change, controlled-substance prescription, refill, prior authorization, laboratory or pharmacogenomic test, accommodation letter, disability form, leave certification, emotional-support-animal letter, or any particular outcome. Every decision remains subject to clinical judgment, informed consent, identity verification, appropriate monitoring, Nevada law, federal law, the prescription monitoring program, payer requirements, and the clinician's professional obligations.
